Students will be provided bus transportation home on late bus days only. Late bus stops differ from regular stops. Students should check the bus listings to be aware of what late bus they should take home.

If you choose to pick your student up instead of them taking a late bus, PLEASE ARRIVE PROMPTLY AT THE CONCLUSION OF THEIR ACTIVITY! Students who are consistently late being picked up will be required to take the late bus home.

Club/activity schedules and information will be posted on the RCMS website under the After-School section as they become available. It will also be sent out via News You Choose. Information will also be offered on the morning news show (RC-TV) and will be posted throughout the school. Encourage your child to stay up to date with current club and activity info.

Continued participation in the After-School Program is contingent on the student's attention to school behavioral guidelines. Student participation in the After-School Program may be denied and parents may be asked to pick up their child if the guidelines, including chronic lateness to pick up, are not followed.
